COACHING & COMPETITION COMMITTEE REPORT

I am pleased to provide the membership with this, my final annual report as Board Director and Chairperson of the Coaching & Competition Committee. I take this opportunity to express my heartfelt thanks and sincere appreciation to the members for their support and encouragement during my time in office.

The State Squad Camp was held on 9 March 2019 at Edith Cowan University (ECU) in Joondalup, with a wealth of knowledge and experience being shared by the State Coaching Panel (SCP) and State Referees' Council (SRC) to our current and future champions.

Western Australia's Premier Karate Event, the State Championships was held on 7 April 2019 at ECU Joondalup. The event was successful and laid the foundation for the competition season ahead.

The Annual Awards and State Team Presentation Dinner was held on 27 April 2019 at Hillarys Yacht Club with the 2018 *Athlete of the Year Awards* being presented and the State Team being announced to the wider community. The evening also acknowledged Mr Brian Mackie, Mr Denis Purvis and Mr Kyoshin Kayo, who were the recipients of the inaugural *Founders Award*, recognising their long-term service and continued efforts in establishing our Federation and development of Karate in Western Australia (WA), as well as Mr Steve Casserly, the recipient of the *Dedicated Services Award* acknowledging his many years of distinguished service.

The Western Australian Karate League (WAKL) facilitated four events including the Senshinkan Open (17 March), Wado Open (19 May), Shobukan Open (30 June) and WA Open (22 September). All events were administered to a high standard, providing excellent opportunities for our athletes and officials to attain the necessary competition experience in their respective fields.

In addition to the WAKL events, Azedin Rghioui, French World Team and European Champion returned to WA, conducting seminars on 25–26 May 2019 and were once again, very well received and supported by athletes and coaches alike.

The Australian Karate Federation (AKF) National Championships were held in Launceston, Tasmania at the Silverdome on 2–4 August 2019. The medals achieved were a result of the collaborative efforts, commitment and dedication of our athletes, personal coaches, state coaches, referees, management team and the ongoing and unconditional support of the parents. Information regarding the State Team selection and results have been tabled for your perusal.

At an international level, Western Australia continues to be well represented with athletes, in particular, Olivia Clifford, Mitchell Durham, Kristina Perrin, Blake Skewes, Hannah Sullivan and Rebecca Sullivan competing at several events including:

- 20th Oceania Karate Championships Sydney, Australia (12 April 2019)
- Pacific Cup & Training Camp Noumea, New Caledonia (23–29 August 2019)
- 11th WKF Cadet, Junior & U21 World Championships Santiago, Chile (23–27 October 2019)
- WKF Series A & Karate 1 Premier League Events (Refer WKF Calendar 2019)

As a whole, I congratulate these individuals on their tremendous achievements as ambassadors for our State and country and trust the experience gained will prove invaluable leading to even more significant achievements in the future.
