All state squad athletes and coaches are to attend training in a WKF-approved Karate Gi, belt and protective equipment.

When on the training floor, only bags with no wheels and soft soled shoes are allowed.

Regional Athletes

WAKF Regional Athlete Definition.

• A regional athlete is defined as an athlete that lives and resides over ninety five (95) kilometres from the Perth CBD.

Regional Athlete Travel Subsidy

The Regional Athlete Travel Subsidy Scheme is a WA Government initiative supporting regional athletes who have progressed into the high performance pathway of their chosen sport and are pursuing regional, state and national representation.

Eligible regional athletes can receive funding for out-of-pocket travel and accommodation expenses directly related to competitions and programs in accordance with the performance level categories and eligibility criteria outlined in the application guidelines.

State Team Athlete General Selection Criteria

For an athlete to be eligible for WA Karate State Team selection, the following criteria must be met in the year the athlete is nominating for State Team Selection.

- i. Must be a registered and financial member of WA State Squad.
- ii. Must be a registered and financial member of Karate Australia.
- iii. Participated in all the State Squad Training Sessions and Camp in the lead up to the selection meeting.
- iv. Compete in a minimum of two (2) Western Australian Karate League (WAKL) events prior to the National Championships.
- v. Compete in the WAKF State Championships.

State Team Commitments After Team Selection to Fulfil Travelling to the National Championships

- i. Attend the WAKF Gala Awards Night.
- ii. Participated in all the State Squad Training Sessions.

Some exemptions apply and are outlined in the State Team Selection Policy - Athletes

Important Guidelines, Policies and Procedures
